Spokane Public Schools – spokanepublicschools.org

SPS is offering grab & go meals – a breakfast and a lunch together – for any child aged 0-18, or currently enrolled in high school, at the following locations from 11 a.m.-noon. Yes, that's any student -- even those who don't attend Spokane Public Schools!

Central Valley School District – cvsd.org

Kids, age 18 and under, can enjoy a free, nutritious, grab-and-go, drive-through or walk-up breakfast & lunch while schools are closed from 10am-1pm at specific designated locations. Registration is not required and children do not need to be a CVSD student to participate. No ID or paperwork required. Children must be present to pick up.

West Valley School District – wvwd.org

For children ages 18 and under, grab-and-go breakfasts and lunches are available at Pasadena Park Elementary; Seth Woodard Elementary; Ness Elementary; and Orchard Center Elementary, Centennial Middle School and West Valley High School.

Mead School District – mead354.org

Children, age 18 and under, can enjoy a FREE, nutritious, "grab-and-go" breakfast and lunch while our schools are closed. Registration is not required and children do not need to be Mead students to participate. However, children must be present to pick up a sack meal, which includes lunch and breakfast for the following day. Meals will not be provided April 6-10, 2020, as this is the week the Mead School District would have been closed for Spring Break.
